<p>Sports Equipment Sporting equipment to be purchased to continue to enhance the quality of the PE lessons taught across all key stages. The new equipment will also continue to assist in the coaching of school teams for upcoming competitions.</p> <p>The purchase of equipment will allow the children to experience higher quality PE lessons. It will also allow children to participate in a variety of activities at lunchtimes (led by coaches), giving them the opportunity to try new sports which they can then continue in after school clubs and team competitions. This will then increase the participation in these sports when they are offered at after school clubs, therefore increasing the number of children at team trainings.</p>		£2500
<p>Sports Kit/Clothing – Kit top up New sports kits purchased with school logo to be used for children participating in school competitions. A variety of kits purchased that are suitable for different sporting events entered. This has allowed children to go fully equipped, in suitable clothing to the different competitions. It will also allow the children to continue to go equipped to future sporting events.</p>		£500
<p>KS2 PE Kits Purchase of new PE kits for each child across KS2. This purchase allows every child to participate in PE lessons in clothing that is appropriate for the sessions that are being delivered. This kit will then make spare kits available to KS1 meaning that each child in the school has appropriate clothing to participate in PE activities.</p>	£1100	
<p>Break and Lunchtime Sports Equipment Equipment for children to use during break times and lunchtimes. Children will use the equipment to support play and to learn new skills. The equipment will also be used to encourage children to take part in team games and games and activities that they may not be familiar with. Therefore allowing children to try new activities, working alongside children from other year groups and classes and members of staff. The new equipment will also support in the activities being delivered by the school's new play leaders.</p>		£2000

<p>Transport to and from sporting events and competitions Coach hire and mini bus travel to and from competitions attended. This will allow KS2 children to participate in an increased number of competitions in a variety of locations. It will give children the opportunity to experience participation in a range of competitive events against other schools across Middlesbrough and the Tees Valley.</p>		<p>£300</p>
<p>Sports Facility Bid Money used for a bid writer in order to write and submit a bid to secure an outdoor sport facility on the school site. If successful the facility will allow the school to deliver high quality PE and coaching sessions in school as well as improving links with the local community by providing sporting opportunities during school holiday times and outside of school hours.</p>	<p>£5000</p>	
<p>After School Sporting Clubs The school now offers a wider range of sporting after school clubs including, dance, football, netball and multi skills. All clubs are led by qualified coaches meaning that children are receiving high quality sessions. The uptake in after</p>		<p>£3200</p>

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<p>school clubs has increased after asking children to suggest clubs that they would like to see introduced. Participation in the clubs has also lead to the increase of children wanting to participate in the sporting competitions available. Clubs are now directly linked to upcoming competitions. Children and parents are asked regularly what clubs they would like to see available which means that children of all ages are constantly offered a wider range of activities. This means that children are able to try new activities, get healthy and participate in clubs after school.</p>		
<p>Holiday Clubs Summer clubs delivered to children from the school and siblings during the 6 week Summer holiday. The clubs allowed the children to continue with sporting activities out of term time, ensuring that they remain active when not in school. Similar clubs to be held in other half terms.</p>	<p>£450</p>	

<p>Yoga Bugs Yoga Bugs is delivered weekly, by a qualified instructor, to children in Reception. This contributes to the children's health and well-being. Helps to improve the health of all children involved regardless of ability. This will continued to be offered to children in EYFS.</p>		<p>£2625</p>
<p>Supply Cover to cover release of staff for sporting events and training. Cover to allow staff to attend training days and sporting events and competitions. This allows staff to take more children to sporting competitions. It also means that staff are available to take children to a greater number of events allowing them to participate in a full range of sporting competitions.</p>		<p>£800</p>
<p>Middlesbrough School Sports Membership Membership of the School Sports partnership to allow access for the children in the school to the wide range of competitions and tournaments that are offered to Middlesbrough Schools.
