Sporting equipment has been purchased to enhance the	
quality of the PE lessons taught across all key stages. The new	
equipment has also assisted in the coaching of school teams	
for upcoming competitions. Some equipment has also been	
purchased to use for activities during breakfast club and	
lunchtimes.	
The purchase of equipment has allowed the children to	
experience a higher quality of PE lesson. It has also allowed	
children to participate in a variety of activities at lunchtimes,	
giving them the opportunity to try new sports which they can	
then continue in after school clubs and team competitions.	
This has played some part in the increased the number of	
children putting their name forward to be entered in to the	
school team events.	
Sports Kit/Clothing	£1100
New sports kits purchased with school logo to be used for	
children participating in school competitions. A variety of kits	
purchased that are suitable for different sporting events	
entered. This has allowed children to go fully equipped, in	
suitable clothing to the different competitions. It will also allow	
the children to continue to go equipped to future sporting	
events.	
Transport to and from sporting events and competitions	£300
Coach hire and mini bus travel to and from competitions	
attended. This has allowed KS2 children to participate in an	
increased number of competitions in a variety of locations. It	
has given children the opportunity to experience participation	
in a range of competitive events against other schools across	
Middlesbrough and the Tees Valley.	

Gymnastics Coaching	£600
The school offers children in KS2 gymnastics sessions, after	
school, led by a qualified gymnastics coach. Lessons allow	
children to experience a sport that they may not get the	
opportunity to participate in outside of school. The club is	
preparing children to participate in upcoming gymnastics	
events, giving children the chance to compete against other	
children in the area.	
As a result of the gymnastics club some children have shown	
interest in joining gym clubs after school.	
Numbers in the club continue to grow allowing children to	
experience gymnastics, encouraging them to participate	
outside of school.	
After School Sporting Clubs	£3200
The school now offers a wider range of sporting after school	
clubs including, dance, football, netball and multi	
skills. All clubs are led by qualified coaches meaning that	
children are receiving high quality sessions. The uptake in after	

school clubs has increased after asking children to suggest	
clubs that they would like to see introduced.	
Participation in the clubs has also lead to the increase of	
children wanting to participate in the sporting competitions	
available. Clubs are now directly linked to upcoming competitions.	
Children and parents are asked regularly what clubs they	
would like to see available which means that children of all	
ages are constantly offered a wider range of activities. This	
means that children are able to try new activities, get healthy	
and participate in clubs after school.	
Yoga Bugs	£2625
Yoga Bugs is delivered weekly, by a qualified instructor, to	
children in Reception. This contributes to the children's health	
and well- being. Helps to improve the health of all children	
involved regardless of ability. This will continued to be offered	
to children in EYFS.	
Supply Cover to cover release of staff for sporting events and	£820
training.	
Cover to allow staff to attend training days and sporting	
events and competitions. This allows staff to take more	
children to sporting competitions. It also means that staff are	
available to take children to a greater number of events	
allowing them to participate in a full range of sporting	
competitions.
